

NKSL ALL-STAR SWIM MEET

July 23rd, 2007 at Ludlow-Bromley Swim Club
Coach and Team Information Packet

All-Star Meet Eligibility: Only swimmers who are NOT entered in an individual event for the Champ Meet are eligible to swim in this meet! If a child is swimming in only a relay event for Champ Meet, they may swim in the All-Star meet.

All-Star Meet Entry Sheets: Due to Jerry Wissman by 4:00p.m. on Friday, July 20th. Please e-mail these entries to Jerry at <mailto:jerry.wissman@fortthomas.kyschools.us>. Include the first and last names for all entries. Please do not be late with your entries; we will need to make copies of the Heat Sheets for distribution at the Meet.

All-Star Meet Entry Fee: There will be non-refundable \$3.00 entry fee per swimmer with a \$6.00 charge maximum per family. The money should be turned in with the swimmer entry sheets. Make checks payable to the Northern Kentucky Swim League, Inc.

Late Entries: There will be **no deck entries** at this meet. If they are not entered by 4:00 p.m. on Friday July 20th, then they cannot be entered later.

Number of Entries: Each swimmer can enter **TWO** individual events. There are no limits to the number of swimmers entered from one team in any given event.

Parking: Please carpool as much as possible. Parking attendants will direct cars in our lot including the grass areas around our lot. The lot will fill up fast. Therefore, we will use Carlisle Ball Field, which is located on Sleepy Hollow Rd., just a short walk from our pool. There will be signs. Pedestrians walking from this location to the pool must use extreme caution and walk to the corner (via bridge) of Deverill St. and Adela St. to cross at the stop sign. **DO NOT TRY TO CROSS SLEEPY HOLLOW RD.;** it is a very dangerous bend at this point. Street parking is permitted on Adela Ave. and neighborhood streets as long as there is no "NO-PARKING" sign. Please do not block driveways.

Meet Entrance: Swimmers and spectators will use the same entrance located at the North gate (left of the clubhouse). Swimmers report to team area. Only swimmers and coaches in the team area please.

Team Areas: Team areas will be assigned in the recreation area. This is a large concrete fenced in area. There is plenty of room for each team to have a tent/canopy.

Admissions: No charge to attend.

Scratch Meeting: A coach's scratch meeting will be held at the official's table at 5:00 pm.

Heat Sheets: Available for \$1.00 at the gate. Coaches and Officials pick-up heat sheets at the official's table. Results posted near rest rooms.

Clerk of Course: Located under the basketball court in the team area. Swimmers must report to the clerk of course to be lined up according to heats and lanes. Volunteers will walk swimmers to the blocks just before their event.

Awards: Medals for 1st-6th place for each event. Participation ribbons will be awarded to all swimmers as they exit the pool. Award podiums located near the flagpole at the shallow end of pool.

Theme: The theme for both post-season meets will be "**Talent, Pride, and Spirit**".

Parade: Will start at 5:45pm; begin lining up teams at 5:35pm. The parade will assemble in the recreation/team area, in alphabetical order, with the host team (Ludlow-Bromley) last. Swimmers will walk the perimeter of the pool beginning at Clerk of Course proceeding behind the blocks, around pool, behind diving boards, in front of spectators, and back to the Team Area for the singing of the National Anthem. Then immediately send your 7-under freestylers to the Clerk of Course. Bring your team banners and decorations.

Scoring: There is no team scoring at this meet.

Disqualifications: Swimmers in all heats may be disqualified for improper strokes or turns. Disqualifications will be recorded and reported to the computer operator. Coaches or swimmers should not approach officials.

Worker Assignments: Worker Sheets should be turned in to Shelly Ridge at jm_ridge@hotmail.com by July 15th. Each team must provide workers for this meet according to the attached sheet. 1st half workers will report to the official's tent at 5:30. Second half workers will be called after Breaststroke. An announcement will be made.
