Parking

There will be parking available in our parking lot and we will have off-site parking and shuttle service as needed. Parking will be challenging, please encourage car pooling.

Coolers/ Food

Coolers are permitted. The Taylor Mill Swim Club will have the concession stand open during all sessions. The Stingrays will have a baked goods table, grilled food and drinks (sodas, water and sports drinks) available for purchase. Taylor Mill Swim Club has a NO ALCOHOL POLICY, so please be sure to pass this onto your parents.

Tents/ Team Areas

Teams may bring tents for their team area, but they **must** be “free standing” with **no stakes or sharp-ended poles. Tents may not be tied to our fence nor can you use stakes.** Each team is expected to clean up their team area after each session.

Team Decorations/ Parade

We cannot permit you to use crepe paper in your decorations for your team area since wet crepe paper stains.

The parade will have teams going in alphabetical order, with the host club, Taylor Mill, going last. Music will be provided for the parade.

Physical Layout

- Backstroke flags will be placed 16’5” from each end.
- There will be colored tape on the lane lines to mark the 15-meter mark.
- We will use 6 lanes for all sessions. There will be 2 outer lanes available for warm-ups but will not be open during the competition sessions.
- We will have touch pads at both ends of the pool, therefore the 8 & unders will be starting from blocks at the starting end of the pool. We will move the timers for the 8 & under events.
- There will be ample deck space for spectators, but they will not be allowed past the roped areas.
- The coach’s area will be on the left (bridge) side of the pool. We will not be using scaffolding to connect the right side of the pool. Coaches will not be allowed behind the blocks.

Clerk of Course

There will be a Clerk of Course for 8 & under and 9-10 individual age group events for both the prelims and finals. The other age groups will be report directly to the starting blocks prior to their events. **All relays will be the responsibility of the coaches.**

Other Info

- There will be a dinner for NKSL Coaches and Delegates between the prelim sessions on Thursday, July 29. Further information is forthcoming.
- We will stop the finals session periodically for the presentation of awards, giving the swimmers the honor they deserve for their accomplishment.
- ***Teams must supply watches for their timers!!***
